DOW'S CORPORATE HEADQUARTERS IN MIDLAND, MICHIGAN supports a commitment to staying on the forefront of innovation by enabling growth and productivity in the workplace. As part of this commitment, Dow will construct a new state-of-the-art, six-story building to replace the current 2020 Willard H. Dow Center. The building will meet the needs of the Company's Midland employee population and further demonstrate its strong ties to the Great Lakes Bay Region.

This development is part of a larger, ongoing initiative to support collaboration, company growth, and innovation-driven business practices. The new facility within the corporate center campus will include a visitor reception area, customer conference rooms, and a cafeteria with an outdoor patio space overlooking a pond and natural area. Construction will begin in Q3 2015 and the building is expected to be occupied and fully operational by the end of 2017.



Dow in Midland

Midland, Michigan is home to The Dow Chemical Company's global headquarters, as well as Michigan Operations, the original production site founded by H.H. Dow in 1897. Dow's continuous growth in the region has most recently led to the addition of the Business Services Center in 2011 and East End in 2014. Midland, an international hub of chemical and technology manufacturing, is known for its strong legacy of leadership, innovation, operational safety and commitment to the community.

CORPORATE CENTER



Dow's global headquarters sits on 150 acres of pristine woodland and includes buildings that house several of Dow's corporate, business and functional groups. The campus also includes a video production studio, employee training center and wellness/fitness center.

MICHIGAN OPERATIONS



Dow's first manufacturing location, Michigan Operations focuses on specialty chemical manufacturing for the automotive, agriculture, electronics, paper, pharmaceutical and bioscience industries, and more.

EAST END



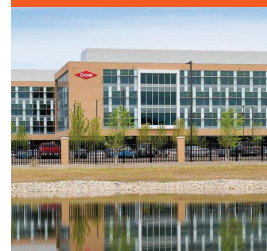
Dow is East End's largest tenant, using about 75 percent of the multi-level building for office space in Downtown Midland.

BUSINESS SERVICES



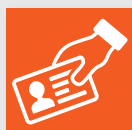
The Business Services Center is a 205,000 sq. ft. multi-tenant building that is home to Dow's Business Process Services Center and Customer Service department.

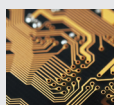
Products researched, developed and/or manufactured at Dow's Michigan sites include key ingredients and innovations that enable hundreds of everyday products including:

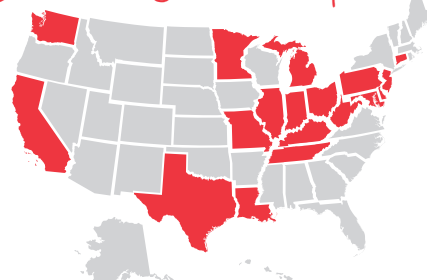


The Dow Chemical Company Foundation donated more than **\$4 million in 2014** to organizations throughout the Great Lakes Bay Region.
